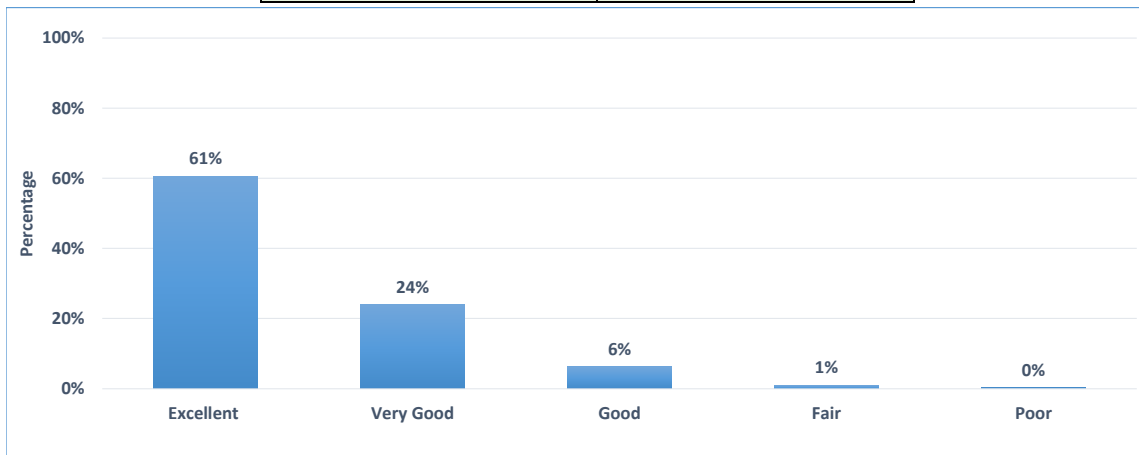

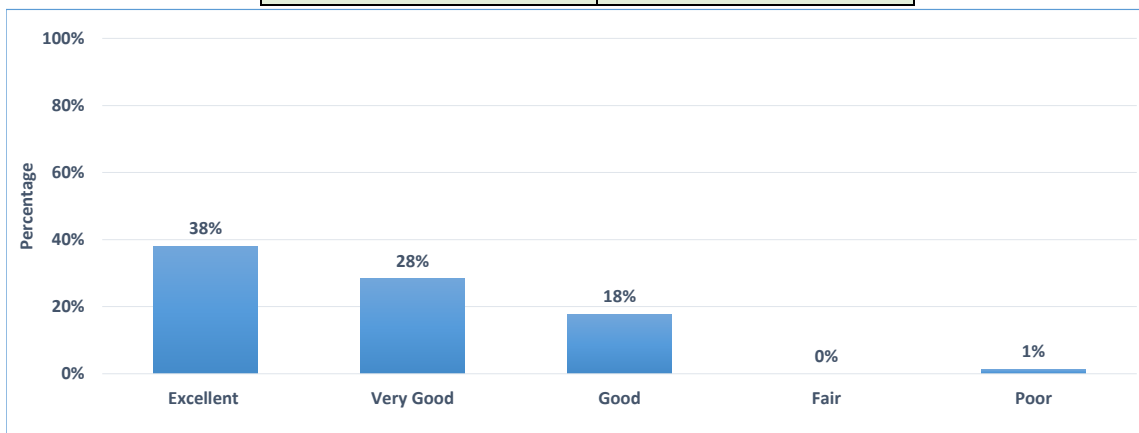
**Part-A: Teaching Learning Process**
