AGENDA 8/1: Confirmation of minutes of Seventh Academic Council meeting held on 17th September 2022.

The Dean-Academics discussed the process of syllabus preparation and presented the syllabus of V and VI semester courses of AI&ML and AI&DS programmes w.e.f. 2023-24. Dr. Mrudula Nimbarte, HoD of Emerging Technologies, highlighted the recommendations made by their BoS members.

The proposed changes in programme nomenclature shall be:

B.Tech. in Artificial Intelligence (AI) and Data Science (Intake 60) to Computer Science and Engineering (Data Science) (Intake 60)

and

B.Tech. in Artificial Intelligence and Machine Learning (Intake 60) to Computer Science and Engineering (Artificial Intelligence and Machine Learning) (Intake 60)

In view of the above, the Computer Science and Engineering department shall offer these new programmes B.Tech. in Computer Science and Engineering(Artificial Intelligence and Machine Learning) and Computer Science and Engineering(Data Science) wef. 2023-24 subject to approval from the competent authorities. The Programme Code for these new programmes shall be as under:

In case, due to any reason if the approval from the competent authorities for the suggested changes in nomenclature is not received, the Institute shall run its 1st Year curriculum with its earlier names.
